

2023 Reference Year Adjustment Factors for Fall/Spring Contract Seed Dry Peas

The quadruple asterisk (****) in the table below designates which year's RYAF is to be used in adjusting the current year's T-Yield (2023) for standard T-Yield variable percentages or yield floor computations.

For low actual yields in years 2019-2022 that are eligible for YA, remember the T-Yields contained within the actuarial documents for 2019-2022 are expressed in 2018 dollar-equivalents. Use the RYAF designation within the quadruple asterisk (****) to derive the corresponding year's T-Yield in its 2023 equivalent value for YA substitution purposes.

For low actual yields in years 2016-2018 that are eligible for YA, remember the T-Yields contained within the actuarial documents for 2016-2018 are expressed in 2015 dollar-equivalents. Use the RYAF designation within the triple asterisk (***) to derive the corresponding year's T-Yield in its 2023 equivalent value for YA substitution purposes.

For low actual yields in years 2003-2015 that are eligible for YA, remember the T-yields contained within the actuarial documents for these years are expressed in 2002 dollar-equivalents. Use the RYAF designated with the double asterisk (**) to derive the corresponding years' T-yield in its 2023 equivalent value for YA substitution purposes.

For low actual yields in years 2002 and prior that are eligible for YA, remember the T-yields contained within the actuarial documents for these years are expressed in 1987 dollar-equivalents. Use the RYAF designated with the single asterisk (*) to derive the corresponding years' T-yield in its 2023 equivalent value for YA substitution purposes.
