LATE PLANTING GUARANTEE REDUCTION CALCULATIONS

Late Planting is available if the crop is planted up to 25 days after the final planting date for the following crops:

0011 (Spring Wheat in dual counties),
0013, 0015 (Except MN and ND), 0016, 0091 & 0094 (WITH 6/30/97 CONTRACT CHANGE DATE) AND 0039 (WITH 4/30/97 CONTRACT CHANGE DATE AND 8/31/97 CANCELLATION DATE).

LPO Reduction for these crops is as follows:

1 - 10 Days Late = 1% per day ex. 5 days * .01 = .05,
11 - 25 Days Late = 2% per day 1.00 - .05 = .95 LPO Factor

Late Planting for Millet (0017) up to 20 days after the final planting date with the following LPO Reductions:

1 - 10 Days Late = 1% per day ex. 12 days LPO 10 * .01 = .10
11 - 20 Days Late = 3% per day 2 * .03 = .06
For every day over 10, 10% additional. .16
1.00 - .16 = .84 Factor

Late Planting is available for Canola (0015) for Minnesota and North Dakota counties up to 15 days after the final planting date with the following LPO Reductions:

1 - 5 Days Late = 2% per day
6 - 15 Days Late = 3% per day

Late Planting is available if the crop is planted up to 20 days after the final planting date for the following crops: 0043, 0075, 0084 (CENTRAL & SOUTH PROVISIONS),

0229, 0230, 0231, 0232, 0233, 0234, 0235 AND 0236.

LPO Reduction for these crops is as follows:

1 - 5 Days Late = 10% per span .90 Factor
6 - 10 Days Late = 20% per span .80 Factor
11 - 15 Days Late = 30% per span .70 Factor
16 - 20 Days Late = 40% per day .60 Factor

Late Planting is available if the crop is planted up to 25 days after the final planting date for applicable 1998 Spring crops with 11/30 or 12/31 contract change date.

LPO Reduction for these (applicable 1998 Spring) crops is as follows:

1 - 25 Days Late = 1% per day, maximum = 25% reduction.
