SIMPLIFIED CLAIMS PROCESSING

(REFER TO MGR-96-005 FOR COMPLETE REFERENCE)

THE CROPS AND CRITERIA FOR A CLAIM TO BE ACCEPTED AS A SIMPLIFIED CLAIM ARE:

1. ONLY THE FOLLOWING 12 CROPS ARE ELIGIBLE: ALMONDS, CORN, COTTON, GRAIN SORGHUM, PEANUTS, PEAS (GREEN/DRY), POPCORN, SOYBEANS, SUGAR BEETS, CANNING AND PROCESSING SWEET CORN, TOBACCO AND WHEAT.
2. CROP POLICIES WITH MORE THAN ONE UNIT EARNING PREMIUM ARE NOT ELIGIBLE.
