Crop Fact Sheets Updated for 2018 Spring Crops

Producers, insurance agents, and insurance company employees are encouraged to use these resources to reference important insurance updates for the 2018 crop year. These crop fact sheets give a summary of the insured crop, causes of loss, the insurance period, reporting requirements, important dates, coverage levels, premium subsidies, prices, unit divisions, insurance plans, a loss example, and contact information.
