## Background

The Federal Crop Insurance Corporation (FCIC) amended the PRH Pilot Plan of Insurance General Provisions for the 2023 and succeeding crop years. The harvest and post-harvest activities definition was revised to provide a consistent accounting and application of those activities.

## Action

The PRH Pilot Plan of Insurance General Provisions (23-PRH) will be available by close of business today on the RMA website at <u>www.rma.usda.gov</u>.

Approved insurance providers must notify policyholders of these changes at least 30 days prior to the cancellation date, as required by the policy.
