Background

The Federal Crop Insurance Corporation (FCIC) amended the Northern Potato Crop Insurance – Quality Endorsement; Processing Quality Endorsement; Certified Seed Endorsement; Storage Coverage Endorsement. For the 2022 and succeeding crop years, premium for these endorsements will no longer be charged on acres prevented from planting.

A Final Rule with this change was published in the Federal Register on April 30, 2021. FCIC invites you to submit comments on this rule through the close of business on June 29, 2021, at <u>www.regulations.gov</u>.
